### **Qualification**

#### **Individual Pairs Event**

Teams are selected by their club director. Each beach club will select their top team. If a player graduated High School in the fall and went to college in the spring, she can NOT participate in the BVCA National Championships as a junior player. [See Guidelines](#)

- The 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams will go into a pool of 3. The winner of the pool will advance into the 70 team Gold, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place goes to 56 team Silver, 42-team bronze bracket.
- Games will be played to 21 in seeding round

- In 12's, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams will go into a pool of 3. The winner of the pool will advance into the 30-team Gold, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams into 15-team Silver, 15-team bronze bracket.
- In 14's, the 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams will go into a pool of 3. The winner of the pool will advance into the 60-team Gold, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams into 48-team Silver, 36-team bronze bracket.
